NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTHIN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSE 1 CO- OPERATION

Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institution and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.

CLAUSE 4VALIDITY

This Agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period Name of Industry (ASPA BANDSONS AUTO PVT. LTD), the Second Party, as the case may be, will take effective steps for implementation of this MOU. Any act on the part of Training Partner or (ASPA BANDSONS AUTO PVT. LTD) Name of Industry, the Second Party after termination of this Agreement by way of communication, correspondence etc., shall not be construed as an extension of this MOU

Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations.

CLAUSE 5

RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

It is expressly agreed that First Party and Second Party are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOUshall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party'scredit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party. Any divergence or difference derived from the interpretation or application of the MoU shall be resolved by arbitration between the parties as per the Arbitration Act, 1996. The place of the arbitration shall be at District Head Quarters of the First Party. This undertaking is to be construed in accordance with Indian Law with exclusive jurisdiction in the Courts of Amravati.
