## Detail Report:

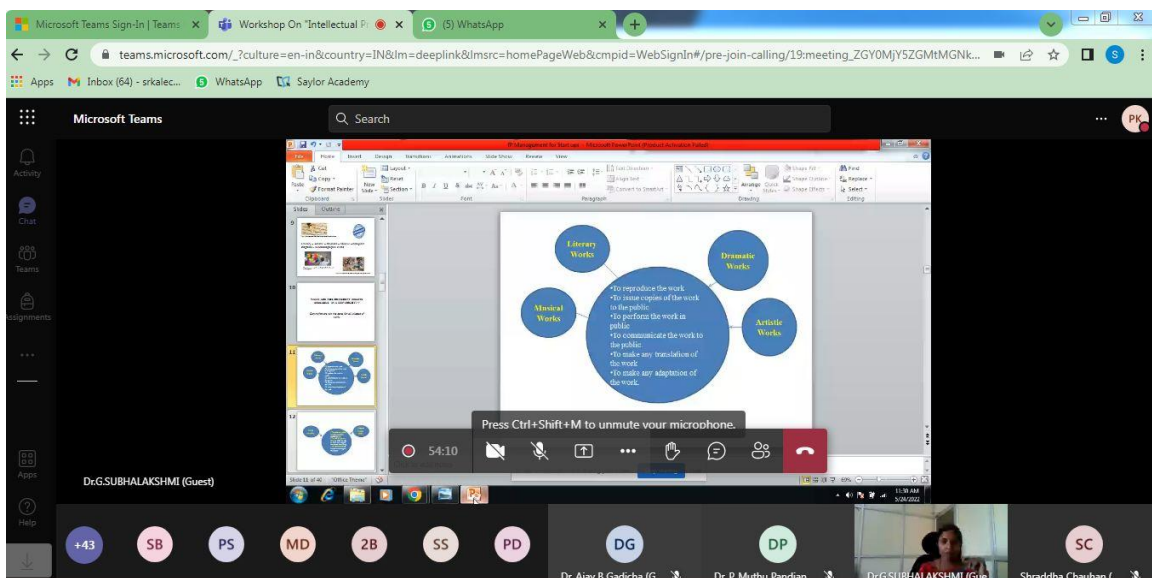

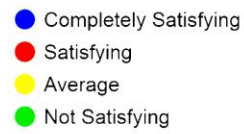

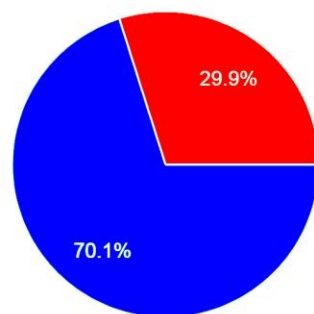
2. How was the Content delivered

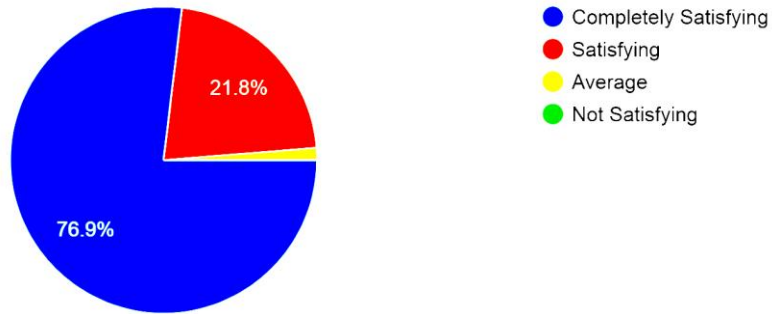
3. How was the event Structure

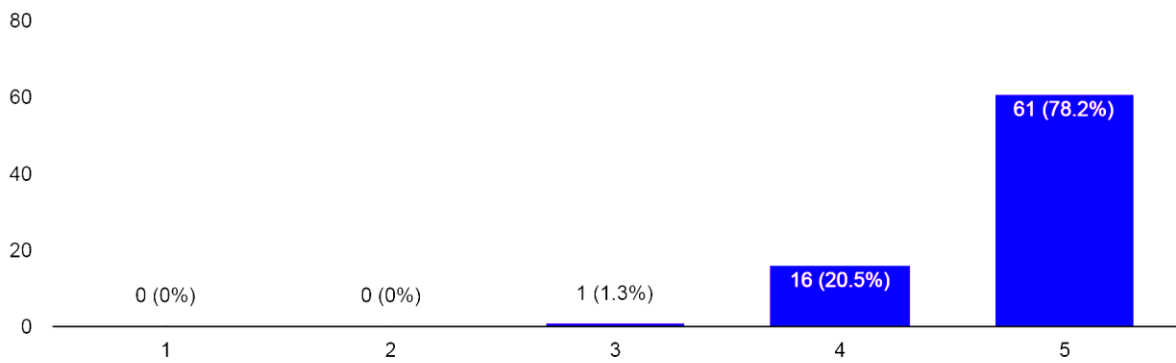
#### 4. Overall experience of the Workshop
